



2024 IN GOP State Convention Delegate Information

Eligibility Requirements to Run for Convention Delegate

1. Must be a resident of the Election District
2. Must be a Qualified Primary Republican
If the last two primaries you voted in were not Republican ballots then you must get an authorization form signed by the County Chairman
3. Must be a Republican in Good-Standing

How to Run for Convention Delegate

State Convention delegate candidates must file a CAN-37 with their county clerk between **January 10, 2024** and **noon on February 9, 2024**.

After filing this form, your name will appear on the Republican Primary ballot on **May 7, 2024**. (Separate CAN-37 form will need to be filed if also running for Precinct Committeeman)

State Convention delegates may also be appointed by county chairmen if not enough delegates run on the Primary ballot to fill the allotted number of spots, or if a vacancy otherwise occurs.

Duties of a State Convention Delegate

Delegates vote to nominate Statewide Officials to the General Election ballot

- In 2024, the candidates up for election are Lieutenant Governor and Attorney General
